### **DAY ONE: FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 12, 2010 – SAN JOSE → SAN LUIS OBISPO (D) – Performance**

- Morning: Load coaches at Evergreen Valley High School and depart for San Luis Obispo. Stop for lunch en route.
- Afternoon: Arrive into San Luis Obispo – transfer to California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo and enjoy a campus tour (and possibly a rehearsal – time permitting). Transfer to the Embassy Suites Hotel, San Luis Obispo and check-in.
- Evening: Dinner as a group. This evening – *Performance* at the stunning Cal Poly Christopher Cohan Performing Arts Center.
- This performance will be shared with one or more local groups.



### **DAY TWO: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 2010 – SLO → MAGIC MOUNTAIN → LA AREA (B)**

- Morning: Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel and load the coaches. Depart for Six Flags Magic Mountain.
- Late Morning: Arrive at Six Flags Magic Mountain. The rest of the day is free to enjoy the park.
- Afternoon: Lunch on own at Six Flags Magic Mountain.
- Evening: Dinner on own at Six Flags Magic Mountain. Meet at the front entrance at closing (likely 8pm) and board the coaches – transfer to the Hampton Inn, Buena Park. Arrive at the Hampton Inn, Buena Park and check-in.

**Afternoon:** Lunch on own at Universal Studios, Hollywood.

**Evening:** Meet at the front entrance and transfer to a restaurant at the Citywalk (likely the Hard Rock Café Hollywood, Buca di Beppo or Bubba Gump).  
Enjoy dinner as a group.  
After dinner, board the coaches and return to the hotel.
